

VOTING FAQs

FOR WHAT I AM VOTING?

Fans will have the opportunity to vote and select the winners of the Entertainer of the Year Award (“Entertainer Award”) and the Show of the Year Award (“Show Award”), which will be given at the 2015 Streamy Awards ceremony on September 17, 2015 (the “Awards Special”).

WHEN CAN I VOTE?

You can cast votes to determine the winners of the Entertainer Award and the Show Award (collectively, the “Awards”) starting September 3, 2015, at 9:00:01 a.m. Pacific Standard Time (“PST”) and continuing until September 17, 2015, at 07:44:59 p.m. PST (the “Voting Period”).

HOW DO I VOTE?

There are two ways for you to cast votes for the winner of the Entertainer Award and the winner of the Show Award: (1) online at either of the following websites: www.vh1.com/events/streamy_awards/vote/ and www.Streamys.org/vote; and/or (2) via Twitter by mentioning specific key words and hashtags as described below in a tweet published on your Twitter account. Both voting methods are further described below:

1. Twitter Voting: To cast your vote directly through Twitter, you must be registered with and logged into Twitter. Your Twitter account must be set to Public.
 - a. You may cast a vote for an Award by composing a message containing the following required key word elements and publishing it from your Twitter account (“Tweet Vote”):
 - i. The official hashtag assigned to or associated with the nominee for the Award for whom you wish to vote (“Nominee Hashtag”);
 - ii. Any form of the word “vote” (e.g., vote, voting, voted, etc.); and
 - iii. The official hashtag for the Streamy Awards: #Streamys.

An example of a valid Tweet Vote would be:

I am voting for #TylerOakley for Entertainer of the Year at the #Streamys

2. Online Voting: You can also vote online through either of the official websites for the Awards Special located at www.vh1.com/events/streamy_awards/vote/ and www.Streamys.org/vote (“Voting Sites”) using your computer, tablet, or mobile device. Votes cannot be submitted (or counted) unless the Voting Period is open (see ‘When Can I Vote?’ below). During the Voting

Period on each of the Voting Sites, you will see a voting widget that will help you generate your Tweet Vote.

- a. On the Voting Site(s), you will be prompted to select the Award for which you wish to vote and then to select the nominee for whom you wish to vote. Once you have selected both, click the “Tweet Your Vote” button.
- b. If you are not already logged in to Twitter on your computer, tablet, or mobile device, you will be prompted to log in. If you do not currently have a Twitter account, you will have the opportunity to register for an account now. Registration on Twitter is free.
- c. Once logged in, a pre-populated Tweet Vote for the applicable nominee will appear. You will have the option of adding a personal message to your Tweet Vote; however, be sure that your Tweet Vote still includes the required elements: (1) the applicable Nominee Hashtag; (2) any form of the word, “Vote”; and (3) the #Streamys hashtag.
- d. Be sure to click “Tweet” to submit your vote.

3. Nominee Hashtags

- a. The list of official Nominee Hashtags can be found below but will not be valid until the Voting Period begins.
- b. Nominee Hashtags do not need to be capitalized for your Tweet Vote to be valid.

4. General Provisions regarding Tweet Votes – regardless of method of casting:

- a. Only Tweet Votes published during the Voting Period that comply with the foregoing instructions and include the required elements will be counted as valid votes.
- b. If multiple nominee names are included in a Tweet Vote, the vote will be disqualified, and no vote will be counted.
- d. If you re-tweet a third party's valid Tweet Vote, it will count as a valid Tweet Vote by you, subject to the same rules for ordinary Tweet Votes set forth above.
- e. Tweet Votes must comply with all other Twitter requirements (e.g., number of characters, etc.) and may not include any derogatory, defamatory, or obscene language or images.
- f. If you do not currently have a Twitter account, you will not be able to vote unless you register for a Twitter account (go to [Twitter.com](https://twitter.com) to register). Registration on Twitter is free.

HOW MANY TIMES MAY I VOTE?

You may cast up to one hundred (100) Tweet Votes per Award per day (midnight PST to midnight PST), whether you cast your Tweet Vote directly or through one of the Voting Sites.

WHO CAN VOTE?

Anyone with a valid, public Twitter account can vote regardless of location.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO VOTE?

Voting is free, except for standard internet access charges which may apply if you are using a web browser or standard data charges which may apply if you are voting via your mobile device.

HOW DO I FIND OUT THE RESULTS?

The winner of the Audience Award and the winner of the Show Award will be announced during the live broadcast of the Awards Special, scheduled for September 17, 2015 at 10 p.m. on VH-1. Check your local listings for more information about show times.

WHY DO I NEED A TWITTER ACCOUNT TO VOTE ONLINE?

Logging into your Twitter account to vote online is a key security feature to guard against voting fraud.

WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE VOTING PROCESS?

Any attempt to deliberately undermine, circumvent, or manipulate the legitimate operation of the vote process is strictly prohibited, including, without limitation, use of fraudulent, robotic, or ghost Twitter accounts, use of multiple email addresses to set up multiple Twitter or Facebook accounts, and/or automated voting scripts, programs, or macros (not including legitimate third-party software that enables the scheduling of tweets, posts or status updates such as HootSuite or TweetDeck). We reserve the right to disqualify the votes from any individuals/entities we suspect or find: (a) to have engaged in manipulated and/or inauthentic voting practices; (b) to have tampered with the voting process; or (c) to be acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other person. Dick Clark Productions are not responsible for technical, hardware, software, or telephone malfunctions of any kind, lost, or unavailable network connections, or failed, incorrect, incomplete, inaccurate, garbled, or delayed electronic communications or for any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the voting process or by any human error which may occur in the tabulation of votes.

HOW IS MY VOTE COUNTED?

The total number of votes submitted during the Voting Period for each Award will be tabulated, and the nominee receiving the highest total number of valid votes for the Award for which he or she was nominated will be declared the winner the Award. If the voting process is interrupted for any reason, is found to have been tampered with in any way, or for any other reason that we believe to be reasonably necessary (for example, in instances of infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical or system failures or disruption, 'acts of God' or terrorist attacks, or any other causes beyond our control), we reserve the right to select the winners of the Awards and may take into consideration the number of votes received by any nominee up until the time of the interruption or cancelation of the voting process.

ARE THE STREAMY AWARDS AFFILIATED WITH TWITTER?

No. Although you may use Twitter in the voting process, the Streamys Award are in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with Twitter.
